

The board has approved a new volunteer proposal put forth by the Operations Officer. These are requirements for being a member of the club. Any questions please email operations officer at [gsc.operationsofficer@gmail.com](mailto:gsc.operationsofficer@gmail.com).

These requirements will begin at time of **renewal** or **new membership**. Operations Officer will keep a record of number of hours worked for each member. Member must stop into clubhouse and sign in for volunteer hours for the day as well as sign out to help keep track of hours properly.

There will be a list every month of matches and things that need to be done. Once full no extras may come. If you sign up and do not show up it does NOT count towards your hours.

If at the end of the your membership you're somehow unable to complete hours after multiple attempts to complete them member will have to discuss with Operations Officer an alternative or forfeit \$50.00 deposit.

The requirements only apply to the main member NOT the member's family. However, if another adult member of the family wishes to cover the volunteer hours for the main member this will be allowed.

RSO's who have opened more than 30 hours or 5 ranges in the past year will be exempt with the understanding that they will continue to volunteer their time. If after a year they do not fulfill the 30 hours for a free membership they may be required to give the \$50.00 deposit.

Range control has agreed to help with the proctored test for RSO on a weekend. They will only do this once every couple of months. A sign up sheet will be at the office. Once we get at minimum 30 people they will conduct the test. You must complete the online test prior to signing up for the proctored exam.

### **Requirements to become a member of Quantico Shooting Club as of Feb. 2016:**

1. Become an RSO and open one range a year for a minimum of 6 hours.
  - There are 8-10 open RSO slots per day. 20 per weekend. 1040 per year.
  - Calendar will be available for sign up for any weekend for the entire year. RSO would be contacted only if range suddenly unavailable. If this happens member must make one (1) more attempt to open range. If again unable do to range scheduling member has fulfilled requirement for volunteer hours and will NOT forfeit \$50.00 deposit.
    - NOTE: Training (mentoring) to open range will only count towards 2 hours of required volunteer time. So if member

trains on 3 (Three) ranges and is released you are done for the year and must start over next year. (RSO is good for 3 years)

- If member opens 30+ hours a year membership is free next year and member may have 10 free guests (\$100 value)

2. If unwilling to become an RSO member must volunteer 8 hours per year.

- There are many needs that the club has been unable to fulfill due to lack of volunteers. Among them are:
  - Shredding documents
  - Filing membership paperwork
  - Cleaning out attic
  - Mowing shotgun field (spring, summer, fall)
  - Weed eating shotgun field (spring, summer, fall)
  - Cleaning out shotgun houses
  - Picking up debris on shotgun field and parking lot
  - Leaf pick up (fall)
  - Painting clubhouse windows
  - Re-sealing clubhouse windows
  - Etc.....

3. Another option for members is to volunteer one day of a Rifle match event.

- Quantico Shooting Club holds many matches every year that are always in need of help. This includes:
  - Stats runner
  - Registration help
  - Water supplier
  - Cooking
  - Pulling in the pits (paid position by shooters not club)
  - Set up/ take down (if needed)
  - Target building
  - Target pasting
  - Pit box restocking
  - Inventory collecting
  - Etc....

4. Last option available is to waive volunteer requirements and pay the \$50.00.

## Acknowledgment of Required Volunteer Hours

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to remember the need to volunteer and to sign up accordingly. It is not the job of the Quantico Shooting Club to remind me to do my duty to the club. By choosing one of the four (4) choices below I accept my responsibility.

- Become an RSO and open one range a year or 6 hours.
- There are 8-10 open slots per day. 20 per weekend. 1040 per year.
  - Calendar available for sign up for any weekend for the entire year. Sign up for any range any weekend. RSO would be contacted only if range suddenly unavailable. If this happens member must make one (1) more attempt to open range. If again unable do to range scheduling member has fulfilled requirement for volunteer hours and will NOT forfeit \$50.00 deposit.
    - NOTE: Training to open range will only count towards 2 hours of required volunteer time. So if member trains on 3 (Three) ranges and is released you are done for the year. (RSO is good for 3 years)
      - If member opens 30+ hours a year membership is free next year and member may have 10 free guests (\$100 value)

- If unwilling to become an RSO member must volunteer 8 hours per year. A list will go out monthly highlighting needs for the club that month.
