In addition to opening ranges for the scheduled matches, your RSO Teams have opened Range 1 or 305 for recreational fire each weekend and with increased interest in Shotgun shooting sports have had International, American and Wobble Trap, as well as the American Skeet fields open.

The July calendar is full of competitive shooting opportunities. This upcoming month there are several matches for GSM Rifle, both USPSA and SCSA Pistol, and Rimfire Rifle PRS. Our first and foremost interest is in safety. In addition to practicing safe firearms handling, don't forget to bring tick repellant, sun block, and plenty of fluids to the range to stay healthy and make your time of the range more enjoyable.

Several members have reported issues regarding base access using their DBIDS cards. The QSC Staff met with the Visitor Control Center staff last week and hopefully the issue has been resolved. If members are still having issues getting on base during the weekend, please visit the VCC again so they can check the coding of your DBIDS card and ensure access to the ranges.

The Club continues to have Range Safety Officer volunteer shortages. If you have been a QSC RSO in the past, the Board encourages you to renew your certifications. If you have not been a RSO in the QSC but you are or were an RSO in the military, law enforcement, or NRA, we can assist you in quickly certifying to open and operate MCBQ ranges for the QSC.
