

Garand, Springfield, and Vintage Military Rifle Match

May 26, 2018

Registration: Preregistration is required, on the QSC web site. Check-in 0700-0800 at the Club House. Firing will begin on Range 3 at approximately 0830.

Vetting forms must be turned in a 2 week prior to the match if you are not a club member.

Parking will be in the Weapon Bn parking lot by the flag pole. The only authorized vehicles down range will be the RSO and OIC. No you may not drive you vehicle down range to drop your gear off. Special consideration will be made for anyone who is handicap. **Bring food and water.**

Rifles Allowed: As-Issued M1 Garand, 1903 & A3 Springfield, and Vintage Military Rifles. As-Issued military rifles are rifles that were or could have been carried by military personnel in combat operations. These matches honor “those who served” and carried these rifles while on military duty and strive to preserve the traditions of military marksmanship.

Entry Fees

QSC members: \$10/1st \$15/2nd \$20/3rd
Guest Fees: \$15/1st \$20/2nd \$25/3rd

QSC members must have membership card available for inspection or you will have to pay guest fee.

Targets: Conventional SR.

Relays: Squading will take place on the 200 yard line.

All 3 matches will be fired on Saturday.

Eye and hearing protection is required in the pits.

Saturday: As-Issued Military Rifle Course A

Stage	Distance	Type of Fire	Firing Position	Number of Shots	Time Limit
Sighting	200 yds.	Slow	Any	5	15 min. for sighting & prone slow
First	200 yds.	Slow	Prone	10	
Second	200 yds.	Rapid	Prone from Standing	10	80 sec.
Third	200 yds.	Slow	Standing	10	10 min.

1 The 200--yard SR target, Rule 4.3.5, is used for all stages.

2 Competitors are given a combined time limit of 15 minutes to fire a maximum of five sighting shots and 10 record shots in the prone position.

3 The time limit for the rapid--fire stage is 80 seconds for both semi--automatic rifles (M1 Garand) and manually operated rifles (Springfield and Vintage Military Rifle).
